

The Consciousness State of Exaltation



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Introduction



According to Michael and the Mother, we're all angels here this lifetime to help with an historic event - a planet-wide Ascension into a brand, new space, taking our physical bodies with us.

This has never happened before and will be followed by the rest of the universe ascending and joining us in that space.

Let me establish at the outset that we're all of us angelics, on Earth today. Here's the Divine Mother on the subject:

Divine Mother: Let me be clear. There is not one being – human, starseed, hybrid or earthkeeper – that is not one of my Angelic Beings. And it matters not whether you belong to the Legion of Michael or the Tribe of Uriel, the Praisers of Metatron or the Truth Speakers of Gabrielle. It does not matter your colour, your hue. You are my Angels, birthed from my being – birthed not only from my womb, but from my heart. (1)

DM: There is no one and no being upon this wondrous Gaia that is not part of your celestial family. (2)

And here's Archangel Michael:

Archangel Michael: At this interception moment of ascension and shift, all present upon the planet, from what has been judged as the most egregious to the most saintly, are angelics. (3)

Archangel Michael: To use your phraseology, there are no day laborers on Earth at this time. None. Now, do you realize what I am saying to you? That the mother who sits by the brazier burner in India or walks the Kalahari in Africa or dances in the street in Rio all have chosen to congregate on this magnificent planet, Gaia, at this time? ...

You have gathered from far and wide, seraphs, archangels, those from the Outer Forces, the Inner Forces. It is a gathering the magnitude of which you are just glimpsing. (4)

As angels, we all dwell originally in the Transcendental, which is the domain past the twelve dimensions. Michael confirms that here:

AAM: The angelic realm, all of us, are not part of that twelve dimensions, twelve planes of human existence. We are a realm beyond that. (5)

However, all angelics come from Source and participate in Source's energy, he says:

Archangel Michael: Think of your planet or even think of your galaxy. Then outside of your galaxy you have what you believe to be deep space.

Now we also know that deep space contains many other galaxies so keep going and keep going and keep going. Now, when you have gone through all of that think of it as being contained in a bubble, go outside the bubble, that's where we are.

Steve: Aah. So, transcendental space.

AAM: Yes. But, also at times the space - now we are going to really confuse you - the space in-between the spaces.

We occupy often the space between the spaces. We come from Source.

Steve: Right. Wow!

AAM: Yes, it is bigger than you think. (6)

And why are we here?

Archangel Michael: The awareness, when you choose to acknowledge it, and the, shall we call it, the angelic abilities, are present in the human race, in the individual human form at this time so that the leap into Nova Being is in fact not as great as it might have been in other ages. (7)

So for me to describe a space called “exaltation” is simply to describe the space that we angelics feel when we’re in our native habitat, the Transcendental, and, evidently, the Absolute or Source as well.

I say below that:

“I imagine these are truncated experiences, which allow me to continue to function. Just tastes of what's to come. AAM might call them "glimpses." "Visit don't stay," he advised me in 2013.” (8)

I can't see how this could be otherwise. An event outside the twelve dimensions would surely be so strong that I'd forget all thoughts of returning to service. So they must have been toned down.

I can imagine that many more people experience exaltation as well, but put the probably-brief experience down to something they ate or a brief moment with God, a gift from the Mother.

It's a gift from the Mother, to be sure, but a very rare experience which is soon to be shared with everyone on Earth capable of holding the energy.

The only one of these recorded experiences that I vividly remember today was the walk home from the coffee shop in 2015. But what they say about the road ahead of us is fantastic. We go from higher-dimensional love to bliss to ecstasy to exaltation ... and beyond.

Mother, I'm ready! Sign me up for the beyond! I want to know what's around the next bend!

Here we primarily investigate the divine quality called ecstasy. I surprise myself often when writing a booklet like this. I find all manner of things that I'd forgotten.

For instance, I think there are several accounts of time spent in exaltation in this book. Exaltation is apparently a higher state than ecstasy.

I'd only remembered the original incident, when I was on my way to a local coffeeshop and entered this sublime state for a few seconds. But there were several more that happened after that. Thank heavens, I wrote them down.

The deeper I go into consciousness, the more I remain in the moment and the more I forget almost everything. Sooner or later, I'm going to have to stop resisting being solely in the moment. But when or if I do, I won't probably want to continue service as a lightworker.

Be that as it may, I assert, as a result of my own explorations so far, that there's a ladder of consciousness, and it goes beyond the Fifth or even the Seventh. It consists of these stair steps: love, bliss, ecstasy, and exaltation.

I know. We're used to thinking of dimensions. But for me, a student of awareness, I'm far more interested in how I feel than what the roadsign says.

Love, bliss, etc., are all just names we've given to deeper and deeper forms of love. As love grows in intensity from what we think of as "love" to bliss to ecstasy and finally to exaltation, we find ourselves turned outward some of the time and inward some of the time - unpredictably. It makes it hard for others to be around us.

Bernadette Roberts found in her spiritual practice a time when she had to be intensely alone. But then, at a higher level (which I think was Ascension for her), she needed to be around people. I personally am in the intensely insular phase.

I'd say that "exaltation" is an indication of a possible space that lies beyond love, bliss and ecstasy. I also suspect that there are countless spaces that lie beyond exaltation and that all is a steadily-unfolding story of ever-deepening grace.

Continuing my ethnographic record of an Ascension, I find myself for a second time in what I can only describe as an "exalted" state.

I know that that word has heavily-negative connotations in our society, but there's no other word for it.

I'm a Connecticut Yankee in King Arthur's court here, rather like the court jester playing the King.

But there's no remedy for that either. I must forge ahead.

How can I describe feeling exalted?

Well, it actually feels perfectly natural, perfectly normal, but it's perfectly natural at all times and in all places. Especially in the places where it counts most.

Its primary impact on a person is to bring to their attention the need to be responsible for their participation. I hear the phrase: "Unto whom much is given, much is expected."

I also hear: "When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child; but when I became a man, I put away childish things." (2)

It'd be inconceivable to feel exalted and act like a child, give in to the ego, or depart from the divine qualities. The two would be incompatible.

One could only feel exalted because one is rock-bottom firm and secure in the knowledge that, ultimately, all is OK, all is taken care of. One's belief in it would have to be unshakeable.

I'd say that, being in that state of felt indestructability, one would be an open invitation to exaltation.

I actually do have an unshakeable understanding that it's all going to work out in the final reel, born of the 1987 vision. (3) It's the time between now and then that worries me, not the outcome. And I think my assurance that all works out goes back further than this lifetime.

But our society frowns on a discussion such as this. I don't think it's ready [Dec. 21, 2015] to entertain that there could be a space, a domain, a state of being called "exaltation." It sounds too elitist, smacking of a nobility or upper class, nose-in-the-air kind of stuff.

And having the notion accepted isn't a battle I want to fight quite frankly. There are more important issues like coming together as a peaceful world and putting an end to gender persecution globally. Those are love-battles worth winning.

Therefore, I'm choosing not to sail in that peak space just yet, for the greatest good.
(4) I probably wouldn't continue my lightwork if I did.

Let's put this one back in the treasure chest and bury it again for a while. We know there's a treasure buried in that field - that one, right over there - and we know we own the field. The treasure isn't going anywhere.

It all works out in the final reel. It all turns out in the end. Everything works towards an ultimate good that resolves all conflicts and dissolves all pain. At this time of year (Christmas), we can exalt in that knowledge.

Again, as a page in my ascension ethnography, I'm basking in transformative love at this moment and I don't know why.

I'm listening to some lovely music. (1) Did that play a role? My life has fallen into place in a way I'd never have suspected, but which is perfect for me. Is that why?

The sense that everything in my life is perfect at the moment seems to be connected to this mood, which I'd call "exaltation." I remain with this sense.

I find myself flowing back and forth between transformative love and exaltation as if there's a connection between the two.

This is what it seems to be. Whenever I see that everything is perfect, "I" drop out of the picture and all that's left is love. When a sense of "I" returns, I find myself in an exalted or ennobled mood.

There's no need for an "I," an ego, in a world that's perfect. There are no survival issues for the ego to handle and no need to seek pleasure and avoid pain. No pleasure can top that available in exaltation.

It's "me" that says that the world is perfect. It's me that realizes it. It's me that lets the realization in, lets it flood me. And that realization dissolves the ego.

Exaltation either ennobles or nobility comes with exaltation. None of this comes with a user's manual! All of it is wordless.

"Exalted" refers to the lofty perch, not to the individual. It's used in the same way that "ascended" is, as indicating a shift in consciousness to a "higher" level of consciousness.

I imagine these are truncated experiences, which allow me to continue to function. Just tastes of what's to come. AAM might call them "glimpses." "Visit don't stay," he advised me in 2013. (2)

As a beachhead of understanding, let me tentatively postulate a connection between the realization of perfection and the arrival of the mood I call "exaltation."

The peace that I was feeling yesterday deepens in exaltation.

The soul that we are is indestructible

Steve: Well, I have four pages of questions, Lord!

Archangel Michael: Yes, I know!

Steve: Why don't I just ask you for a synoptic answer?

AAM: The one [synoptic] answer is yes! (1)

I'm still in the same mood I was in yesterday. (2) I said that I'd experienced a number of "higher" states over the year 2015. I spent the year off and on in love and bliss.

But the highest state, which I experienced extremely briefly, I thought of as exaltation. When I asked him about it, Michael identified it as a transcendental experience. (3)

When I asked my mind today to give me a single word that would help me understand this particular spiritual state, it shot back the word "indestructability."

I believe that to mean that exaltation rests on the certainty of our indestructability.

When I take those words, "I am indestructible," and use them as an affirmation, I almost begin to shiver. And then my chest expands.

Yet this is just a simple truth, is it not? The soul that we are is indestructible. Show me a spiritual tradition that does not teach that.

In 1977, I had an out-of-body experience which demonstrated to me that I was in fact not the temporal body, which I experienced upon re-entering, but the eternal soul or spirit inside the body, the one doing the re-entering.

Wwwwellllll, what is this? I said. I'm not the body! I'm *inside* the body! I'm the operator of the the body! And the insights poured forth. (4)

So it's no challenge for me to say I have no everyday fear of death. That fear disappears the instant one sees that one is not the body.

But that OOBIE was fifty years ago. To take it further and to really get it now, to experience it, to realize my indestructibility, it could turn out, is a very high state.

I love Blossom's Affirmation: I am the Truth. I am the Love. I am the Light. I am.

Let me explore what results from affirming, "I am indestructible. I am." Something about it resonates with me. It's like a general remedy for an undiagnosed illness. My curiosity is piqued.

By "transcendental," I mean from beyond the Twelve Dimensions. Note that this meaning is different from that of classical enlightenment theory, which calls the "transcendental" the exit from the experience of form, an event that happens at the seventh chakra, within the Third/Fourth Dimension.

Beyond the blackness of space....

There's the Transcendental and then there's the Transcendental. We use "transcendental" in two different ways in our enlightenment and celestial literatures.

In our enlightenment literature, the "Transcendental" refers to our experiencing of a formless reality. We usually reserve that term for what we experience in seventh-chakra enlightenment, Brahmajnana, or God Realization.

We "see" a formless reality. We lose consciousness of form. Our senses stop operating. And we're filled with bliss.

BUT we're still within Third/Fourth-Dimensional reality.

The celestials use the word "Transcendental" in an entirely different way. I refer mostly to Archangel Michael, with whom I had readings and interviewed for *An Hour with an Angel* from 2010 to 2020.

In their messages, they speak of the "Transcendental" as the domain of consciousness beyond all of the dimensions. When that has had a chance to sink in, here comes another: Beyond the Transcendental, which I recall Michael saying has dimensions itself, lies the Absolute.

I once interviewed a galactic group on the nature of the Transcendental and they said it was like walking through the blackness of space and seeing bubbles, which one could peer into. Each bubble was a universe.

Later they declined to permit me to use the interview. But the Transcendental is beyond not only universes, which exist on a dimensional level, but dimensions.

OK, turn the fan on. Give your brain a chance to cool down. ... I am soon finished.

The celestials have the ability to come down here and animate Third-Dimensional people and they have the ability to return to revitalize themselves by returning to the Absolute, according to Michael (and I'll furnish quotes in a future article).

If that doesn't stretch your mind, think of life at the level of microbes, then at the level of universes, then at the level of material dimensions, then at the level of Transcendental Dimensions, then at the level of the Absolute. What part is less miraculous than any other? Microbes? Or the Absolute?

The Transcendental is a way station on the journey back to the One. This - Dimensions, Transcendental, Absolute - is the roadmap of the vision I had in 1987. (1)

Haven't seen any of this on Youtube? Isn't in the bookstores for Christmas? Stay tuned. Not tomorrow, but in our future.

Never mind a trip to the stars. How about a trip to other dimensions?

Archangel Michael has offered us two ground-breaking discussions of dimensions in the Transcendental recently.

The only other time I've seen such a discussion is Sri Ramakrishna's description of his visit to one of the Seven Sages and his disciples, both of whom were living happy lives in the Transcendental.

There was the inference that Sri Ramakrishna himself came from a domain higher than the Transcendental, at the mere mention of which my ears perked up. I began salivating.

It became obvious to me in reading these two discussion where my passion lies. It lies in the exploration of the outer reaches of inner space.

So far the Transcendental has been the farthest reach of inner space. But Sri Ramakrishna may have been pointing at a higher domain.

And then, God being unlimited and omnipotent, anything is possible. Why could not everything we can conceive of just be towards the beginning end of possibility.

In any case, spiritual orthodoxy has it that the Transcendental is silent, still, and undifferentiated - One without a second.

But Archangel Michael says here that our view is not correct. Or maybe it's not a long enough view of the subject. It's incomplete. Or compressed, like an accordion file.

There *is* movement in the One - the movement of love, for instance. And there are beings - the angels are just the most obvious - who live in the Transcendental. But apparently, as he tells us here, the ascended masters do as well.

In terms of spiritual outlook, this information is earth-shaking to me. I was beginning to see it earlier, but keeping it filed under "Unsolved Mysteries" and certainly not wrestling with it or its implications.

But, with these two discussions from AAM, I realized that the time had come when I had to admit the notion into my belief system that there was differentiation and life within the Transcendental and the actual moment of surrender/realization/acknowledgment shook me.

If it's taking me this amount of time to adjust to this knowleged, imagine how it'll be for those who discover that there's other life in the universe or that Jesus is not the only Son of God - we all are.

These two passages acre examples of the momentous new information we'll all be hearing in the not-so-distant future and their potential to reshape our spirituality.

Part of this article was posted earlier, but I'd like to repost the entire discussion in one piece.

Please allow me to express my exuberance in places. It's hard to restrain myself when I come upon a topic as exciting for me as this. Exploring inner spaces is to me what looking for the new world was to Columbus.

Steve Beckow: Is it appropriate to call the Mother, “Love in action” and the Father, “Love in stillness”?

Archangel Michael: That is a wonderful way to express it.

Steve: Now within the transcendental of course, there is no material movement but there is plenty of movement of love, right? So it’s not as if the Father is absolute stillness from all things, just stillness from material things.

By this time, I'm already retreating a bit from the view that the Transcendental is absolute stillness...

AAM: It is just a quality of what you think of as form or materiality that translates in your understanding, as stillness. ... The Father would claim and say, if he was to speak, that he is very dynamic!

Steve: But not in anything material or phenomenal....

AAM: It is not necessary.

Because the Father only has to will and it happens? Acts without acting, moves without moving?

Steve: There are people living in the transcendental. For instance, Swami Vivekananda and various of the circle of Sri Ramakrishna were to be found in the transcendental, is that not correct?

AAM: Yes, that is correct.

Steve: So people live there? Are there such things as the equivalent of dimensions in the transcendental?

AAM: Yes.

Steve: Aaahhh! When are we going to hear about that?

AAM: Not for a while. (Archangel Michael in a personal reading with Steve Beckow, Feb. 17, 2017.)

Is this an instance of information that we're not ready for yet? Probably.

This is a mass Ascension and the celestials have their timetable of spiritual disclosure, I'm sure.

But I can't stop my mind from opening like an accordion file, like a gulper eel, to take in the ramifications of what he's just said here. The secret is out and I'm resisting letting go of it.

Not since I spilled all the cards in my card file onto the floor (the sum of which later became From Darkness Unto Light) have I felt such a need to totally reorganize my spiritual knowledge.

Steve: I always thought that Ascended Masters were fifth-dimensional beings but they are in all the dimensions, aren't they?

AAM: Yes, they are.

Now, it is the same as you. Each of you have places where you love to congregate and your favourite planet and your favourite ray and your favourite dimension.

So if there is a gathering place where they would congregate, it would be the 11th dimension but that does not in any way limit where they are free to be, or to work with, or, depending on even the mission and purpose of the day, where they will show up.

Steve: Alright, but all of them, once they have mastered, so to speak, the 12th dimension, do they then enter the transcendental?

AAM: Yes

So humans do not become angels, although angels can become humans, but humans can enter into and live in the Transcendental. Please mark "Inhabited by angels, humans, and others" on the map of the Transcendental where it currently says "Uninhabited."

Where else could I get this new map of heaven except from a celestial like Archangel Michael?

I'm stunned at what I'm hearing and don't know what question to ask him next and I so simply ask him to tell me more.

Steve: Anything you want to say more about that, that I'm not asking but that the readers would love to know?

AAM: Understand that when you have reached a level of ascendancy, you have the ability to completely transcend or you may continue in a different pathway.

This so much changes my understanding of the Transcendental. You do? Where can I read more about that please? I could get lost in this.

The Ascended Masters that you know and many that you do not know, have chosen to be in the realm of those 12 dimensions so that they can continue to work with you. That is their commitment to the Mother.

So it is not as if they are trapped in the 12 dimensions. There is a fluid doorway there for them.

Steve: Now you say they are in the transcendental. There's no differentiation in the transcendental, is there?

AAM: That is correct.

Steve: So is the differentiation into angel, seraphim, ascended masters... If it's not in dimension, what is it in? Light?

AAM: It is. Light and sound... And light is sound and sound is light.

Steve: ...and sound and light are love.

My head is swimming by now.

This information was like finding the correlations that cracked the Biblical code for me. (1) I'll reflect on each part of it, each sentence.

But of course exploring the outer reaches of inner space is where it's at for me. You may find this discussion boring. We're all different.

*So there **is** differentiation in the Transcendental - just not differentiation as we'd know it and recognize it. But differentiation in light, sound, and love, all of which are shown to be one and the same.*

This opens up a whole new world to explore.

Where else could one get confirmation of this? For me, what Michael says here is pure gold.

AAM: That is correct. But that does not mean that you cannot choose, in that, to exhibit in a dimensional reality because you have that creative power. That is the only way I can think to explain it.

Steve: Boy, we may have to discuss that more in the future because I think a lot of people... I don't think we understand matters in the higher dimensions very well.

AAM: No, you do not but you will. It is something to look forward to and that you have been engaged in for a long time and there are times when it will simply click in and you will say, "Oh yes, I remember this." (Archangel Michael in a personal reading with Steve Beckow, Jan. 20, 2017.)

Phenomenal. Fantastic - for me.

I've just been offered a whole new world, an inner universe to explore. For those who can't wait to get aboard the New Jerusalem or the Neptune, this for me is my invite to the inner mothership.

There I'll find Sri Ramakrishna's devotees, most prominently Swami Vivekananda, Sri Ramakrishna himself (although I hope to meet him here in the flesh as well), all manner of ascended masters, angels, archangels, seraphim. No, the Transcendental is not a vast clear soup of undifferentiated bliss. People live there.

Outer space can wait. But I definitely want a seat on the first ship that sets out to explore the inner world of the Transcendental.
